

WHAT IS THE INFANT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM?

It is a program that:



Specializes in early intervention and assessment

Is free of cost to families

WHO IS THE PROGRAM FOR?

Any infant or child from birth to age five, who may be at risk for possible developmental delay because of:

Complications during pregnancy/labour/delivery

Difficulties in the newborn period Eg., prematurity, seizures

Diagnosed conditions such as Down Syndrome, spina bifida, cerebral palsy, sensory impairments

Any family who may need ideas and information regarding how to enhance their baby's/child's development

How does the Program Work?

A Developmental Consultant will visit you in your home

Frequency of visits are mutually agreed upon

WHAT SERVICES ARE PROVIDED?

Service coordination

Developmental assessments

Family service plans and individual program plans designed to assist the parents in providing appropriate activities and experiences based specifically on their infant's or child's needs

Information regarding other community services and referrals are made as required

Individual/group support and education
