Thank you for your request to participate in the Residential/Day Treatment Services Program at the Nipissing Detoxification and Substance Abuse Programs.

The enclosed forms must be fully completed and received to consider your application to the treatment program:

- ☐ 1. Application for Agency Admission
- ☐ 2. Pre-Admission Health Form (must be completed by a physician or registered nurse)
- ☐ 3. Pre-Printed Physician's Orders (PPO) (must be completed by a physician only)
- ☐ 4. Crisis Plan

We also required that an ADAT (Admission and Discharge Assessment) or GAIN Q3 MI ONT (Global Approved Individual Needs) current within six months be completed by an addiction counsellor. Please contact the addiction treatment service within your area to schedule an appointment. You may also contact ConnexOntario Drug and Alcohol Helpline at 1-866-531-2600.

Please note that missing information could result in the referral form being returned for completion, which could delay the referral process. Referral forms are available on our website at www.nbrhc.on.ca, at the King Street Campus or can be mailed upon request.

You will be notified by phone of the scheduled admission date and a letter will be sent to the mailing address provided in your application form. If you are available on a short notice, your name will be added to the wait list in case of any cancellations. Approved applications are assigned the next available date. Please note that housing/accommodation must be secured in advance for your discharge from treatment.
